- Plans - Q3 2016 groundwater, surface water, sediment, stream, leachate, and air monitoring completed in accordance with the facilities' NYSDEC approved environmental monitoring plan. Mill Seats Q3 2016 Environmental Monitoring Report concludes that: "The third quarter sampling activities of 2016 for the Mill Seat Landfill environmental monitoring program demonstrate that landfill operations do not appear to have impacted the water quality of the surrounding area." Q4 2016 field sampling underway. Awaiting results.

NYSDEC monitor Joe Melito is on-site. Daily operational/compliance report is completed daily. No issues.
