

**Mill Seat Landfill Citizens Advisory Board Meeting
October 15, 2019**

The meeting was called to order at 6:00pm by Chairperson Peg Steffan.

Barb Robinson motioned, seconded by Ken Kuter to approve July 16, 2019, meeting minutes; unanimously approved.

Operations Report – given by Jeff Richardson

The Tonnages for the **third quarter** (July, August, September) 154,507 and 46,598 BUD/RGC, for a total average tons per day of 2,007 (MSW) and 605 (BUD). The leachate discharged to the sewer was 2,895,163 gallons. Landfill gas sent to the flare was 154,752 mscf and gas sent to the Power Plant was 313,665 mscf (in millions). The Power Plant generated 13,680,266 kwh using 17,596 engine hours (8 engines). 26,394 barrels of oil were saved.

Revenue Sharing – Town of Riga \$624,039.75; (total for 2019 \$1,716,785.50); Town of Riga (collection) \$89,000.00 (total for 2019 \$267,000.00); Town of Bergen \$15,450.67 (total for 2019 \$42,404.06); Totals for the year 2019 – Bergen Fire Department \$8,203.04; Byron-Bergen Schools \$109,469.82. Revenue sharing for Town of Riga and Town of Bergen are estimates; a check was mailed to the Bergen Fire Department.

Capital Projects/Equipment –Cell 5B 12” gas header installation was completed in September 2019.

Community Involvement – David Muoio reported: Open House at Mill Seat will be July 23, 2020; Scout Day at Mill Seat on October 14 – 65 local boy & girl scouts and 28 adults gathered for a landfill tour and learned about Monroe County/Waste Management EcoPark and the “Do’s and Don’ts” of recycling; happy with the turnout; great event overall; next year Scout Day 2020 will be held at High Acres Landfill. Mill Seat has received WHC recertification through December 31, 2020. Sponsored the July 31st concert at the Village of Churchville gazebo; participated at and sponsored the Churchville-Riga Chamber of Commerce golf tournament and was a presence at the Churchville Lions Country Fair August 17 & 18.

Compliance – Compliance Management system current; no violations to report; 100% compliant.

Safety – Waste Management safety programs including Mission to Zero, Safety Alerts, Rule Book, Drive Cam, NY area safety program, overweight and Safety Training and Documentation utilized daily. Drive cam has been installed on all licensed vehicles. Mill Seat operations have been OSHA lost time injury free for over 601 days.

Environmental Monitoring –Quarter 3 2019 – completed and no issues. Quarter 4 2019 is underway.

NYSDEC – Operational/compliance reports completed; no issues.

Notifications – No notifications or issues for the 3rd Quarter. Fall season litter cleanup along 490 is complete; discussion about how nice everything looks. Luann Meyer reported that Cascades will be out again; to be done by October 31, 2019.

Committee Reports

Budget –Cindy Jessop reported that the normal amount was put into the Riga Town Budget

Environmental Monitoring–Mark McAnany reported that 29 out of 30 have the same statement in the 3rd Quarter sampling report; Luann Meyer and Jeff Richardson will look into that one (page 13, M8A) and get back directly to Mark.

Safety – no report

Property Protection – no report

Old Business – Chairperson Steffan brought up the Sexual Harassment Training; Peg will double check that everyone on this Board is supposed to complete this training.

New Business

- Cindy Jessop gave Nicole Simonetti the address of a resident on Chili Avenue who had questions about trucks, etc; Waste Management will follow up with resident. There was discussion about waste composition, recycling, etc.
- Luann Meyer reported that Monroe County held a hauler safety outreach on September 10 with SWANA (Solid Waste Association of North America); she suggested to Dave Muoio that the information cards could be given out at the Gate House at Mill Seat.
